

Application Procedures  
Registered Exporter and  
Certificate of Origin User for ASEAN-Australia-New  
Zealand Free Trade Agreement (AANZFTA)

1. Companies must be registered, before applying for a Certificate of Origin (CO) for ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand Free Trade Agreement (AANZFTA).
2. Applicants must follow the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) rule of origin assessment procedure ("A Guide to Determining the Origin of Goods under TAFTA") full text of the agreement including all Chapters and Annexes can be found at <http://www.dfat.gov.au/FTA/aanzfta/#business>
3. Applicants must undertake their own investigation and verification process to confirm compliance with the DFAT procedure with regard to the products for which they seek to export.
4. Complete the "Authorised Signatories" form.  
  
(These signatories must be updated; the chamber must be informed of any change to the delegated signatories as they occur. Please note if the signature on the CO does not match our record of Authorised Signatories, the CO will not be issued.)
5. Once the chamber has confirmed successful registration of an exporter, exporters may complete CO on the relevant ACCI CO template, as per the attached instructions. (copy of Certificate of Origin template along with companies Exporter's Australian Chamber Registration No. will be e-mailed with every registration)
6. Exporter Registration status will be reviewed from time to time.
